<b>Description</b>	A signed agreement made between the government of Guinea Bissau and the military junta declaring an immediate truce and outlining a process for negotiations. The agreement includes an Annex of 26 July 1998 concerning the understanding on (and implementation of) point 1 (c) of the memorandum of understanding, and a declaration by the self-proclaimed military junta in which they state their intention to lay down arms.
