Security Guarantees Page 1, The main item on the agenda was the review of the implementation of the Gali Protocol of 8 October 2003. Discussions focused on measures taken to defuse tension in the zone of conflict; ways for improvement of the efficiency of existing security mechanisms; and on topical issues in light of the current situation. In this context, the sides discussed the possibility of a resumption of the work of Working Group I of the Coordinating Council.

Page 1, Having positively assessed the results of the ad hoc high-level meeting of 8 October, the sides agreed to:  
Take every measure to ensure the strict observance of the Moscow Ceasefire Agreement of 1994 and refrain from any action, which may destabilize the situation in the zone of conflict and have a negative impact on the peace process;

Police Page 1, 1.3. Instruct law enforcement agencies to continue their cooperation and to regularly exchange information, based on concrete evidence;
