They agree not to make public statements on the topics included in this document until the process is completed, and to include the Catholic Church and international inspectors as observers ('verificación') who will evaluate the implementation of the process of compromise as agreed in this document by March 1. The compromise document builds on previous agreements. It includes reinsertion (incl. education, employment projects, citizen projects) as part of pre-agreement transition, culture and recreation, guarantees (incl. publication of the process document in 5 national newspapers (1 page), TV programme, establishment of 5 'casas de la paz', joint press conference with international media representatives in Feb, a conference for combatants in one of the camps – incl. guarantees for safe journey there and back), regional planning, human rights (incl. foundation for the support of families of victims of the violence) inter alia.

Training for productive projects: the survey will be used to design the various training programmes based on the joint work of two representatives from both parties. Insofar as possible, activities will commence in the camps.
- e. Training for public participation: the government will arrange courses on Colombian institutions for designated groups at each of the camps.
