Page 1, Article 4, The arrival sites are located in the municipalities of La Uribe (Meta) and San Vicente del Caguán (Caquetá), where military operations of the armed forces will be suspended for 60 hours from when the helicopters enter this area. Page 1, Article 5, To guarantee strict compliance with this commitment, the guerrilla delegation will maintain permanent radio contact with the peace council and the Mexican Embassy in Bogotá for the duration of this period. |
