The work of the management committee shall end with the resolution of the dispute which constitutes the subject of their establishment.</p> <p>Page 1, Article 5: In the event of the violation of this current pact by one of the undersigned members, that member will face the opposition of all the other members.</p> <p>Page 1, Article 8: To deploy joint high-level missions on the ground for the consolidation of the present pact, henceforth the definitive agreement,</p> <p>Page 2, Article 9: The establishment of a monitoring commission composed of two representatives per undersigned movement.</p> <p>Page 2, Article 10: In the event of aggression against one or several of the undersigned members by an external actor, the latter will face the opposition of all the undersigned members in a coalition.</p>
