	Lasting 7 months, this undeclared border war erupted at the height of the Sino-Soviet

	supporting Communist rebels against the nationalist Koumintang. However, relations
	soured over differences in ideology and leadership and although a border treaty was
	drawn up in 1965, Nikita Krushchev refused to sign after allegations by Mao Zedong were
	leaked that Tsarist Russia had stripped China of its historical territory. Accounts of the

The coordinates of the point the mating face of the borders of the three states: Geographical: 49°06,9' north latitude; 87° 17.2' Eastern Longitude; rectangular: X = 5 442 595, Y = 15 520 905, height - 3327. The coordinates of the mark and heights are given in the Coordinate System 1942 and Baltic system heights.
