- 6. It was unanimously agreed that the culprits should take full responsibility of paying the fines or penalties all by him/herself and his clan as earlier stipulated.
- 7. The fine should be paid by the culprit with immediate effect following any incident
- 8. The compensatory cows will be collected by the local peace committee
