- c) a Council composed of a maximum of 30 members among residents of the participating municipalities, including all mayors of the participating municipalities; the Council is an advisory body which provides guidance to the work of the Association/Community.
- d) a Board composed of 7 members voted by the Assembly from among the mayors and residents of the participating municipalities, the exact composition to be defined in the Statute, with the right to take the necessary decisions for 2 the daily management of the Community/Association. The members of the Board will be supported in their work by professional collegia composed of experts, divided into and covering those areas falling under the objectives and tasks of the Association/Community. The Statute will define the number of professional collegia and their assignment to the members of the Board.
- e) an administration, headed by a Chief of Administration appointed by and reporting to the Board, supporting the work of the Community/ Association, in particular the Board and the President.
