Description Serbia and Kosovo tacitly approved an EU proposal to normalise relations,

led by EU's chief diplomat Josep Borrell during talks in Brussels. The EU-brokered plan, supported by all 27 member states, outlines 11 points including each party's commitment to non-violence, mutual recognition of official documents, and non-obstruction of each other's progress towards EU membership. The finalisation and implementation of the plan will be discussed in further leaders' talks, focusing on the specifics of an annexe and potential resolutions to contentious issues, aiming ultimately for a legally binding agreement on comprehensive normalisation of relations. Status of agreement is listed as 'unclear' due to post-hoc dispute as to whether this

was actually agreed and accepted by all parties.
