The meeting expressed significant concern regarding the ongoing insecurity, humanitarian crisis, and socio-economic decline due to violence by armed groups and heightened tensions between the DRC and Rwanda. The Council called for the immediate cessation of hostilities, revitalization of the Peace, Security, and Cooperation Framework for the DRC, and the deployment of the East African Community (EAC) Regional Force to promote regional peace, and urged the international

community for financial and technical support.
