<b>Description</b>	The National Government and the Central General Staff of the FARC-EP declared the initiation of a Peace Dialogue Table to discuss and approve a temporary, national ceasefire. The preliminary phase of the dialogue will involve representatives from the Office of the High Commissioner for Peace, UN Verification Mission in Colombia, the MAPP OEA, the Catholic Church, and the World Council of Churches; they will discuss the protection of communities, civilian population, and adjustments to the ceasefire protocol, among other agenda points. In their joint statement, both parties expressed a strong intention to construct a peace agreement to end the armed confrontation and promote comprehensive, stable, and enduring peace, with an emphasis on social and environmental justice.
