I. DESIGN OF THE PARTICIPATION PROCESS

In the design phase, the ways in which society will participate shall be established. (Locate in agreement)

The process shall be facilitated by the National Committee on Participation, a special and temporary body of the peace talks panel that has a specific mandate and is coordinated by the latter. (Locate in agreement)

II. THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE ON PARTICIPATION AS A TEMPORARY AND SPECIAL BODY OF THE PEACE TALKS PANEL FOR THE DESIGN OF THE **PARTICIPATION PROCESS**

The National Committee on Participation is a temporary special body attached to the peace talks panel. It is composed of 81 members, representatives of the 30 social movements, ethnic peoples, organizations, trade associations and institutions listed in annex 1 to Agreement No. 9. (Locate in agreement)

The Committee is led by the peace talks panel, and should achieve the following objectives of the design phase: (Locate in agreement)

- Present a conceptual, operational and logistical plan to promote and facilitate the involvement of society in the design of the participation process. (Locate in agreement)
- Promote and develop spaces for dialogue with a differential approach, in which the various components of society can present their proposals to design the participation method. (Locate in agreement)
- Systematize the proposals of the social groups convened. (☐ Locate in agreement)
