Description

The Era Kone Covenant represents a collaborative effort between the Government of Papua New Guinea and the Autonomous Bougainville Government to address the outcomes of the Bougainville Referendum on Independence. It details the procedure for tabling the referendum results in Parliament, with a commitment to implementing the referendum's conclusions between 2025 and 2027. Furthermore, the Covenant stipulates joint formulation of a report to Parliament and acknowledges the binding nature of international agreements, emphasizing adherence to internationally recognized human rights conventions.
