<b>Description</b>	A short communique from the Personal Envoy of the Secretary-General for Western Sahara setting out that talks were held between Representatives of Morocco and Representatives of the Frente Polisario in New York. In particular a debate was held over implementation of Security Council Resolution 1754. The parties also heard presentations by United Nations experts on specific issues such as natural resources and local administration, and confidence-building measures were also proposed for future discussions.
