ASWJ shall be integrated into the TFG. The TFG shall allocate to the ASWJ government positions as follows:

1. Five (5) Ministers of categories A,B,C;
2. One (1) Minister of State;
3. Five (5) Assistant Ministers of categories A, B, C;
4. Five (5) Directors-General of categories A, B, C;
5. Five (5) Directors of Departments of categories A, B, C;
6. Three (3) Deputy Commanders of the National Armed, Police and Security Forces;
7. Three (3) Ambassadors;
8. Three (3) Consular Officers;
9. Three (3) Commercial Attaches; 10. Three (3) Military Attaches;
- and 11. Three (3) Cultural Attaches.
