Description

This framework agreement provides for commitments from the government, specifically drafting an amnesty law, supporting the DDR process, integration of Chief of Staff in the Army; armed groups commitments to adhere to the DDR programme, to accept the presence of child protection organisations, renounce to the armed movement in these areas and have everyone accept the principles of 'Bunia, Aveba et Kawandroma villes sans armes' (cities without arms) and to immediately stop the mistreatment of the civilian

population.
