Link to national process: articulated rationale It seems difficult to link the agreement to the national peace process, which is not mentioned in the text of the agreement. On the one hand, Russia aims to foster negotiation between al-Assad government and opposition factions to stabilise the country and reach definite peace. On the other side, in the agreement, the Free Syrian Army reaffirms its devotion to the revolution "until the realisation of a free and noble Syria", which implies that Bashar al-

Assad must leave step down.
