Seven Points Agreement Between Myanmar Government and

Kachin Independence Organization

May 30, 2013 Myitkyina City, Kachin State

(1) The Government of Myanmar and the KIO agree to hold political dialogue.

(2) The Parties agree to undertake efforts to achieve de-escalation and cessation of

hostilities.

(3) The Parties agree in principle to establish joint Monitoring Committees.

(4) The Parties agree to continue to undertake relief, rehabilitation, and

resettlement of the internally displaced persons (IDPs) in consultation with each

other.

(5) The Parties agree to continue discussions on military issued related to

repositioning of troops.

(6) The Parties agree to the establishment of a Myitkyina-based KIO representative

and technical team in order to undertake necessary measures for the peace process

more effectively.

(7) The Parties agreed to continue to allow the participation of representatives of

all observer groups that are present in the peace meeting held on May 28-30, 2013

for the upcoming meeting. If either wishes to invite additional observers, the

Parties also agreed to invite these additional observers in consultation with each

other.
